Borbála Benda (PhD 2005) started to study the 17th-century history of the Erdődy family while I was working with the publication of the letters of Erzsébet Rákóczi (Rákóczi Erzsébet levelei férjéhez, 1672–1707. Bp., 2001.) since her husband was from this aristocrat house. She was a participant of the project 'Family network of the Hungarian aristocracy in 16–17th centuries' between 2003-2006 led by Katalin Péter and financed by Hungarian Research (OTKA).
